US-Compatible Time Zone	CT/CST overlap makes CDMX the rare LATAM hub that works for US employers without schedule hacks.
Cultural Depth	World-class museums (Soumaya, MUAC, Antropologia), theatre, and a top-5 global food scene.
Perpetual-Spring Climate	18-25C most of the year at 2,240m elevation -- no AC required in most housing.
Excellent Value on Food	Market-to-Michelin range with markets that rival any in the Americas on quality and price.
Creative Community	Dense artist, designer, and founder population in Roma/Condesa.
Domestic Help Economics	Full-time housekeeper/nanny runs USD 400-700/month; reshapes dual-income family economics dramatically.
Airport Connectivity	MEX and NLU cover most of North America with direct flights; 4-5h to NYC/LA and 2-3h to most US hubs.

Temporary Resident Pathway	USD ~2,600/month income proof unlocks a 4-year residency visa -- well-trodden and straightforward for remote earners.

Key Risks

Risk Factor	Impact Summary
Seismic Activity	CDMX sits on a former lakebed; 2017 and 1985 earthquakes caused significant damage. Verify building age and soil-zone classification before signing any lease.
Altitude Adjustment	2,240m elevation affects sleep, cardio capacity, and overall energy levels for the first 2-6 weeks. Plan a softer schedule for month one.
Security (Neighbourhood-Specific)	Central/south zones (Polanco/Condesa/Roma/Coyoacan) are low-incident; north and outer-east zones are materially higher-risk for expats.
Tax Residency Trigger	183-day rule applies; Mexican tax residents face worldwide income taxation. Structure carefully with a Mexican CPA before committing to a long stay.
Water Quality	Tap water is not potable; all drinking/cooking water must be bottled or filtered. Garrafrones (20L jugs) run MXN 50-80 and delivery to apartments is standard.
Taxi / Airport Scams	Street taxis and some MEX airport operators overcharge foreigners. Use Uber, Didi, or authorised-taxi desks at MEX Terminal 1/2 (pay inside the terminal, not curbside).
